

# THE BARN

The Barn offers banquet-style seating for up to 60 or talk/conference arrangements for up to 80 people, it provides a flexible space for a variety of users and purposes. For private function/parties and public events we can also offer a licensed bar facility featuring a selection of local beers and ales along with wines, spirits and soft drinks.

A biomass stove provides under floor heating, good on-site parking, outside picnic area and a full range of audio and video equipment including a large format digital projection system, 2kW PA system with 24 channel mixing desk, lighting rig, staging, lectern, and comfy padded seating. The Barn is fully licensed seven days a week for all forms of entertainment and functions.



Heron Corn Mill is a Grade II\* listed watermill and fascinating visitor attraction. Demonstrating 900 years of renewable energy use, we are open year round. Why not book a tour of the mill and hydro-turbine, finishing off with refreshments and some archive films shown in the barn? Group tours must consist of six or more people. 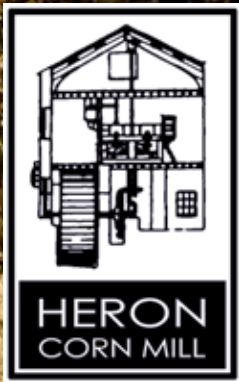

### VICTORIAN FARM

Victorian Farm is an historical observational documentary series following a team who live the life of Victorian farmers for a year. Produced for BBC 2 by Lion Television, this documentary saw a team of three historians, Alex Langlands, Peter Ginn and Ruth Goodman, recreate rural life as it might have been in 1885. It was filmed through four seasons in 2007 and 2008, and first broadcast early the following year accompanied by a best-selling book. With viewing figures of more than six million for each episode, the first series of Victorian Farm proved enormously popular.

Ruth Goodman from Victorian Farm invites you during National Baking Week to join her in a lively discussion of all everything that milling and baking meant to our Victorian forebears, during the year upon Victorian Farm, the grain was grown, harvested, threshed, milled, baked and finally eaten.
